Green Built Home Builder Responsibilities:

This is a voluntary agreement between the Builder and Green Built Home. The agreement applies only to those homes the Builder enters into the program during the enrollment year for which the Builder has paid the appropriate fees. Green Built Home makes no representations or certifications regarding homes registered except that the Builder has agreed to comply with the standards as set forth by the Green Built Home Checklist, and will certify to the home buyer that each home meets the program's minimum standards.

The Builder agrees to the following:

1. All homes registered as a Green Built Home (GBH) will meet the Basic Requirements **(including Energy and Waste Reduction & Recycling requirements)** and earn a minimum total of points as set forth by the **Green Built Home Checklist**. Please note, cardboard recycling is required by state law and is a Basic Requirement of Green Built Home. Reasonable efforts must be taken to meet this standard.
2. The Builder will complete a Green Built Home Checklist for each registered home or elect to certify homes according to the Green Built Specifications method and pay associated fees.
3. At least one home will be enrolled in the program each year.
4. The Builder will substantially participate in promoting Green Built Home and allow use of the Builder's name in GBH promotional efforts, including print and electronic media. "Substantially participate" means that at a minimum, the Builder will:
 - ⇒ Display GBH signage, educational materials and logo in model homes and sales offices.
 - ⇒ Use the GBH logo in print advertising.
 - ⇒ Ensure that sales reps have a working understanding of GBH and its benefits.
5. Signage and other promotional materials will be provided according to the Green Built Home Signage and Promotional Materials Distribution Policy. This policy outlines those promotional materials that are provided as part of the Builder Enrollment and/or home registration fee(s) and those that are available for purchase at cost from Green Built Home.
6. If all homes are not built to Green Built Home standards, the Builder will clearly distinguish in advertising and promotional efforts those homes registered with GBH from those that are not.
7. Green Built Home and its partners will randomly check at least 10% of registered homes to maintain quality control and program credibility. Verification will require that builders provide information such as: copies of plans, rating certificates, spec sheets, invoices, labels, product literature, and material safety data sheets (MSDS) as documentation. If deficiencies are found, Green Built Home will offer follow-up assistance to correct them. Consistent failure to correct deficiencies will result in removal from the program.
8. If Builder is unable or unwilling to meet the Responsibilities listed herein, all GBH signage, literature and promotional materials will be returned to the Green Built Home offices and the Builder will refrain from further identification with Green Built Home through name or use of the GBH logo.
